

CIPES 2ND PHD STUDENT WORKSHOP

The CIPES PhD Student Workshop is an **academic event which seeks to disseminate and improve PhD students' planned, ongoing or recently completed research in the topics of Higher Education and Higher Education Policies**. It is **open to all PhD Students from any institution or nationality** with a thesis on these topics.

This event provides a discussion forum to PhD students in Higher Education from a variety of areas, such as Educational Sciences, Economics, Psychology, Sociology, Public Policy, Political Science or Management. It has the goal of enriching PhD students' research and to provide a networking opportunity for those students among other junior researchers and the senior researchers from CIPES.

The event will be held **at CIPES, in Matosinhos, on the 21th of July**. A small lunch will be offered to all participants at 13:00. The workshop is totally free of charge. **Participating students are expected to send their research contribution in the form of a working paper**. During the workshop, each student will make a 15-minute presentation, followed by a 10-minute review by another participating student. The following 10 minutes will be allocated to a discussion among all participants, promoted by one of CIPES senior researchers. Participants will have access to all papers beforehand and each one will prepare a review on a colleague's paper. At the end of the Workshop, **the board of CIPES will give a "Best Paper" award to one of the participants**, based solely on the evaluation of the papers sent to the workshop.
